

HAS THE INDIVIDUAL REQUESTED A REASONABLE ACCOMODATION- ASKED FOR AN ANIMAL IN CONNECTION WITH A PHYSICAL OR MENTAL IMPAIRMENT?

IF YES- PROCEED TO PART III

IF NO- THE HOUSING PROVIDER IS NOT REQUIRED TO GRANT A REASONABLE ACCOMODATION THAT HAS NOT BEEN REQUESTED.



PART III- DOES THE PERSON HAVE AN OBSERVABLE DISABILITY OR DOES THE HOUSING PROVIDER (OR AGENT) ALREADY HAVE INFORMATION GIVING THEM REASON TO BELIEVE THAT THE PERSON HAS A DISABILITY?

IF YES- SKIP TO QUESTION 7 TO DETERMINE IF THERE IS A CONNECTION BETWEEN THE PERSON'S DISABILITY AND THE ANIMAL

IF NO- PROCEED TO NEXT QUESTION



HAS THE PERSON SEEKING THE ACCOMODATION PROVIDED INFORMATION THAT REASONABLY SUPPORTS THAT THE PERSON SEEKING THE ACCOMODATION HAS A DISABILITY?

IF YES- SKIP TO QUESTION 7 TO DETERMINE IF THERE IS A CONNECTION BETWEEN THE PERSON'S DISABILITY AND THE ANIMAL IF EITHER ANSWER IS NO- THE HOUSING PROVIDER MAY DENY THE REQUEST UNLESS THIS INFORMATION IS PROVIDED. MUST ENSURE THAT YOU PROVIDE THE TENANT WIRH AN OPPORTUNITY TO DO SO BEFORE DENIAL.

- The request for a reasonable accommodation with respect to an assistance animal may be oral or written.
