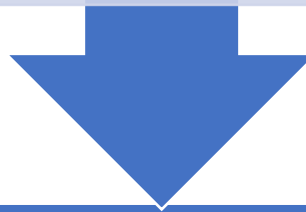

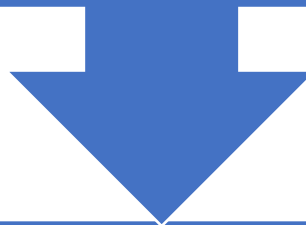
**IF YES- PROCEED TO PART IV**

**IF NO- THE HOUSING PROVIDER IS NOT REQUIRED TO GRANT A REASONABLE ACCOMODATION THAT HAS NOT BEEN REQUESTED.**



**IF YES- THE REASONABLE ACCOMODATION SHOULD BE PROVIDED UNDER THE FHA UNLESS THE GENERAL EXCEPTIONS DESCRIBED BELOW EXIST**

**IF NO- A REASONABLE ACCOMODATION NEED NOT BE PROVIDED, BUT NOTE THE VERY RARE CIRCUMSTANCES DESCRIBED BELOW.**



**UNIQUE ANIMAL BURDEN- NOT COMMONLY KEPT IN HOUSEHOLDS (DOG, CAT, SMALL BIRD, RABBIT, HAMSTER, GERBIL, OTHER RODENT, FISH, TURTLE, OROTHER SMALL DOMESTICATED ANIMAL THAT IS TRADITIONALLY KEPT IN HOMES)**

**TENANT HAS SUBSTANTIAL BURDEN OF DEMONSTRATING A DISABILITY-RELATED THERAPEUTIC NEED FOR THE SPECIFIC ANIMAL OR THE SPECIFIC TYPE OF ANIMAL (ALLERGY, ANIMAL DOES SOMETHING A DOG CANNOT)**
